

Al-Huda School Re-Accreditation Objectives (Approved by CESS-MSA)

Number 1:

By the year 2020, 85% of students, from KG to 12th grade, will be proficient in the subject of Reading (i.e., vocabulary and reading comprehension)

- *by placing in the range of 76th to 100th National Percentile Rank in Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS),*
- *by scoring at grade level proficiency on the Measure of Academic Progress (MAP),*
- *by demonstrating competency (70th to 100th percent) on students benchmark assessments*
- *by scoring 3 or above in the AP English Test*

Number 2:

By the year 2020, 85% of students, from KG to 12th grade, will be proficient in the subject of Mathematics (i.e., concepts, probability and statistics, problem solving and computational skills)

- *by placing in the range of 76th to 100th National Percentile Rank in Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS),*
- *by scoring at grade level proficiency on the Measure of Academic Progress (MAP),*
- *by demonstrating competency (70th to 100th percent) on students benchmark assessments*
- *by scoring 3 or above in the AP Calc AB Test*

Number 3:

By the year 2020, all features of a System-Wide Assessment Program (administration of multiple standardized assessments such as ITBS and MAP, curriculum alignment to standards, development of benchmark tests, comprehensive teacher training for data analysis) at Al-Huda School will be operational and functional in improving student achievements and skills by the following measures:

- *100% of students participating in standardized testing*
- *100% of curriculum alignment to standards in English and Mathematics*
- *100% of benchmark tests will be developed*
- *100% of teachers trained in formative and summative data analysis*

Number 4:

By the year 2020, improved programs and services at Al-Huda School will support the physical, social, and emotional development of students as measured by the following:

- *100% of all meals will meet state's nutritional guidelines*
- *25% of all activities offered at each school level will be extracurricular activities*
- *25% all activities offered at each school level will be academic support and enrichment activities in (i.e. Math and English)*
- *25% all activities offered at each school level will be life-skill activities*
